COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE ARGENTINE FEDERATION OF ASSOCIATIONS OF RADIOLOGY, DIAGNOSTIC IMAGING AND RADIOTHERAPY (FAARDIT)

AND

THE RADIOLOGICAL SOCIETY OF THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA, TAIWAN (RSROC)

This Cooperation Agreement, dated as the signature date below ("Effective Date"), is by and between the Argentine Federation of Associations of Radiology, Diagnostic and Radiotherapy, ("FAARDIT") and the Radiological Society of the Republic of China, Taiwan ("RSROC").

WHEREAS, the FAARDIT has been established for the purposes of bringing together specialists in Radiology, Diagnostic Imaging Radiotherapy of Argentina and enable collaboration of scientific, cultural, social and ethical principles globally.

WHEREAS, the RSROC has been established for the purpose of furthering research, education, and clinical practice in radiology.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of and reliance upon the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, and for the purposes of promoting the means for scientific exchange between both societies, both parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Promote and facilitate the exchange of information and encourage activities between both parties.

2. Encourage radiologists from both Argentina and Taiwan to participate in congresses, conferences, courses and other scientific events organized by either party.

- a. FAARDIT and the RSROC agree, if requested by the either party, shall send one or more highly regarded physician in Diagnostic Imaging and/or Intervention, as a representative, to be, but not limited to, a lecturer, panelist, moderator and more, to annual meetings organized by either party, ("National Meetings"). Specific representative may be requested by the party organizing the event or suggested by the other non-organizing party. Generally, the local party hosting the event will cover the expenses associated with hotel accommodation, meals, and registration fees. The non-organizing party sending the lecturer will be responsible for airfare and related transportation expense.
- b. Members of FAARDIT will have the right to a preferential registration, equal to the members of RSROC, in Courses and Congresses organized by RSROC.
- c. Members of RSROC will have the right to a preferential registration, equal to the members of FAARDIT, in Courses, online activities and Congresses organized by FAARDIT.

3. Promote the training and integration of professionals through scholarships and accommodation between both radiological communities.

4. Promote and make it convenient for exchanges between main academic and research groups associated with either party.

5. Promote teaching activities, written materials, including, but not limited to books, periodic magazines and publications related to the specialty in both Taiwan and Argentina.

6. Promote the translation of papers, protocols and regulations.

7. Both parties shall exchange data, information and related materials of their members on an annual basis, to allow the parties to enjoy the benefit and purpose of this agreement under the appropriate confidentiality.

8. All communication, exchanges of data, information and materials between the two parties, whether arising out of this agreement or otherwise, shall respect and follow the principles of the health care information and the protection of personal privacy.

9. Both parties shall act reasonably in promoting and following the guidelines and principles of this agreement.

The above concepts are the foundation from which the FAARDIT and RSROC declare a relationship between the radiological communities of Argentina and Taiwan.

Both of the organizations agree to sign this agreement in duplicates in English. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, each of the parties hereto has executed this Cooperation Agreement, or caused the same to be executed by its duly authorized representative as of the Executed Date, and effective upon the Executed Date.Buenos Aires, Argentina – NOVEMBER 11, 2013
