

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between:

the European Society of Radiology (ESR)

and

the Argentine Federation of Radiology (FAARDIT)

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") was made on July 5 ("effective date"), by and between the European Society of Radiology ("ESR") and the Argentine Federation of Radiology ("FAARDIT").

The parties hereby agree to the following:

Article 1: Purpose and Scope

1. To promote constant academic collaboration and exchange between the two societies
2. To expand partnership between the two societies

Article 2: Areas of Collaboration

The areas of collaboration between the ESR and the FAARDIT could include, but are not limited to, the following initiatives:

1. Mutual invitation of society representative(s):
The ESR will invite the FAARDIT (one representative) to the ESR International Forum at ECR annually. Simultaneously, the FAARDIT will usually invite the ESR (one representative) to their annual meeting. The host society will cover registration and official social events; airfare, accommodation, and ground transportation will be covered by the mother society.

Article 3: Timing

1. A business meeting will be held based on the agreement between the two societies when this is required.

Article 4: Future Cooperation


1. The present MoU will be valid for 2 years, i.e. until July 5, 2025.
2. This MoU can be revised by both societies after 2 years or sooner if mutually agreed.

The present MoU elucidates the general conditions and arrangements for the future cooperation

between the concerned parties. It is not legally binding on the parties. The exact terms and conditions of this future cooperation will be negotiated.


